Writing

Write a finding tale based on the structure of 'Gangsta Granny'. Use effective noun phrases for description. Use 'show don't tell' to show the reader how the character is feeling.

Know how to use dialogue effectively, punctuated correctly. Write an explanation text using appropriate layout features. Develop an understanding of the use of causal conjunctions. Start sentences using subordinating conjunctions. Use formal language and generalisers to group ideas.



Maths

Number - fractions Identify unit and non unit fractions of shape. Understand the denominator as the whole and the numerator as the amount shaded or had. Order fractions on a number line. Explore equivalent fractions using number lines and bar models.

Geography

Keeping it local

Understand where we are in the world. Use and identify symbols and key on maps. Plot routes and ways using digital maps of the local area. Use digital maps to make observations about human and physical geography.

Compare and contrast a variety of maps and aerial photographs. Read four figure grid references on an ordnance survey map. Use fieldwork to collect information to draw a sketch map. Use grid lines and create a map key.

Use cardinal and ordinal points for orientation. Use maps from the past to identify how the local area has changed over time.
