Dates for the clubs

For the Autumn term, all clubs will commence the week beginning **14 September 2026** until week ending **11 December 2026 (excluding half term and Inset Days)**. The clubs will begin straight after school at **3:30pm and finish at 4:30pm**. Children should be collected in the designated meeting area near the school gates from the adult who runs the club. The 'Showcase' will take place during the week beginning **Monday 7 December 2026**

Cost for clubs

The charge is **£5.75** per child per session, therefore the cost of each club for the Autumn term will be **£69.00** (for **12 weeks**). Thursday clubs will cost £63.25 due to Learning Conversations on Thursday 22 October 2026. In addition the clubs on Friday will be **£57.50** as school is closed on Friday 23 October and Friday 27 November for Inset days. If your child is **Pupil Premium**, then the school will fund your child's place at **one** club throughout the year. This reasonable charge is intended to fund resources required for these activities and also contribute to investing in the school in a variety of ways. Please note that we are unable to offer refunds for any sessions that are missed due to illness or appointments.

If you are in receipt of tax free childcare vouchers, payment can be made to the school via the childcare voucher provider. When the payment is received by the school we will manually credit the payment item on Arbor. To find out if you are eligible or for more information, [click here](#).

Booking a club via Arbor

Clubs will be available to book and pay for, via a payment item on **ARBOR**, from **7pm on Monday 13 July 2026**

Once the clubs are available to book please select 'Clubs' from the dashboard or quick actions. You will see all the available clubs for your child. Select which club you would like to enroll your child in and press the green button at the top 'Register for this club' which will enable you to make payment. Please note a payment must be made to secure your child's place in the club applied for. This will secure your child's place in the club. If you cannot see the club there are no more spaces available.

Places will be allocated on a first come first served basis. Please do not book your child a place in the club unless you are sure that they want to partake, as booking unwanted places may prevent another child from being successful in joining the club. **We are unable to offer refunds should the club be booked in error or if your child no longer wants to attend.** Once the club is full, you will no longer be able to view the payment on Arbor, so in that case, please email the school office, in order for your child to be added to the waiting list. Once payment has been made your child's place in the club is secured. If your child no longer wants to attend a club please inform the office to cancel your place although there will be no refund.

External clubs

Externally run clubs should be booked directly through the provider using the details provided above. These clubs will begin straight after school at 3:25pm and finish at 4:30pm (unless otherwise stated). Children should be collected in the meeting area by the school gates from the adult who runs the club.
