Half termly curriculum connections map

Our curriculum connections maps show where there are opportunities to join children's thinking together by linking it to previous learning and experiences. This strengthens understanding and helps build long-term memory. The ability to build long-term memory of a body of knowledge and to apply that knowledge is central to improving learning.

The connections map also shows links to future learning so that children begin to build the 'big picture' of a subject.

Knowledge organisers

Each knowledge organiser is a summary of the key knowledge, skills and vocabulary that we intend children to know by the end of a unit of work. They can be used in class to review and systematically recall learning, a process known as retrieval practice, which strengthens long-term memory.

These documents also provide a really clear way for parents to understand what their child is learning. Please talk to your child about what they already know and what they would like to find out more about. This discussion could be a starting point for your child's half termly Learning Quest project.
