Turn adjectives (describing words) into adverbs (how the robot works) and use opinion phrases.

From Adjective to Adverb: In Spanish, we often add -mente (like the English "-ly") to the feminine form of an adjective.

Rápido (Quick) ----> Rápidamente (Quickly).

Persuasive Phrases:

- ¡Es el mejor robot del mundo! (It's the best robot in the world!)
- En mi opinión, es esencial porque... (In my opinion, it is essential because...)
- Creo que es muy útil. (I think it is very useful.)

Key Sounds

j v ll

j

he 'J' in Trabajar (to work) is a breathy, raspy "H" sound (like in "Ham")

v

'V' sounds like a soft 'B'. When you say Lavar (to wash), it sounds like "La-bar."

ll

'll' sounds like a 'Y'.


