Year 3 have planned an exciting visit to Grovelands Park as part of our topic about our Local Area. The purpose of the visit will be to develop the pupils map reading and navigation skills. Pupils will be using maps to explore Grovelands Park which will link to our geography sessions.

Therefore please drop your child off by the gate to Grovelands Park that is situated on the Broad Walk, N21 (opposite Woodcroft N21) at 9:30am, where your child's class teacher will be waiting and we will take the register there. If your child is in the breakfast club, they will walk down with the class teacher to meet the rest of the class.

Please speak to your child's class teacher if you have any questions or issues with the arrangements.

This is a free trip and children will not require a lunch as we will return to school for lunchtime.

Your child should wear their school uniform and ensure they have a warm coat and appropriate footwear. **Pupils will not be required to bring their chromebooks or reading diaries into school on the day.**
