## **End of Year Teacher Assessment**

This year, we've updated how we report your child's attainment and effort in all subjects to give you a clearer and more comprehensive picture of their learning journey.

Attainment: How We Measure Academic Attainment

Your child's report will use the following short codes to indicate their attainment, reflecting their understanding and application of the curriculum for their age. The level of detail in the assessment varies between core (English, Maths and Science) and foundation subjects (e.g. Art & Design, Computing, Design & Technology, Geography etc), as outlined below:

We understand that children develop at different rates, and these updated assessments are designed to give you a more detailed and accurate overview of your child's attainment and effort. Your child's class teacher is always happy to discuss their report with you in more detail and answer any questions you may have.

## **Year 1 Phonics Assessment Results**

As you may know, children in Year 1 throughout the country took part in a phonics screening check in June. The screening check is a short, statutory assessment to ensure that children are making sufficient progress in their phonics skills to read words and are on track to become fluent readers who can enjoy reading for pleasure and for learning. You will receive your child's results today alongside your child's End of Year report.
