Dear Year 5 Parents

Coach travel to Voice in a Million on Wednesday 18 March 2026

Travel arrangements

It is not long until Voice in a Million – only 5 weeks! We are writing to inform you of the cost of the coach travel and arrangements for returning your child to school.

The cost of travel to Wembley SSE arena is **£22** per child payable via Arborl > Activities > Trips > Yr5 VIAM Coach. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium or has Free School Meals the school can support you. Please make payment by **Friday 6 March**.

There are two options to collect your child after VIAM:

- Collect at 10pm from **collection point I** outside the arena.
- **Or** collect your child from the school roundabout at 11pm (children will be travelling back to school by coach)

It is vital that you complete this [form](#) by Friday 6 March to inform us your child will be collected.

Tickets

You should have received an email from VIAM with a link to buy tickets once you have registered consent. You can also use this link: [Audience tickets](#) I do hope you will come - it will be a great evening!

Songs and dances

You have already created a login using your email and a chosen password when you gave your permission for photos and videos. If you haven't done that yet, you need to do this as soon as possible because **your child cannot attend VIAM without photography and filming consent for media and DVDs.**

T-shirts

The t-shirts you have ordered will be given to the children on the day. They will change into them after their packed meal before the concert.

Essentials for the day

- School uniform
- Packed meal (this is their dinner)
- 2 large water bottles
- Comfortable shoes and waterproof coat
- Bag for their packed meal/water bottles to carry with them

Lunch and dinner

Lunch: Children will have their lunch as usual at school before leaving on the coach (either Pantry/packed lunch- whichever is their usual).

Dinner: However it is essential you provide your child with a packed meal (as outlined above) for their dinner which they'll be taking with them to have at the venue.

The Following Day: Thursday 19 March

The following day, as the children will be tired, they may come to school at 10.00am. They should go straight to their classes and will be registered there. Siblings are expected to be at school at 8.45 am as normal.
