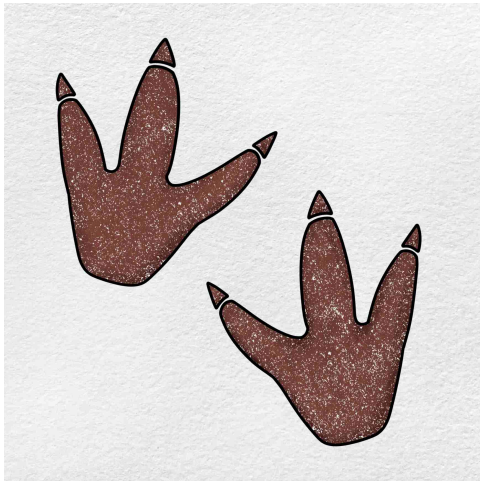

Dear Parents,

Across the Summer term, the children have been focusing on the topic of **Living and growing**. In this topic we will also be looking at the prehistoric world and the fascinating life of Mary Anning, who's most famous discovery was of the complete skeleton of the plesiosaurus. We have invited a *Life Long Ago* workshop to visit our children on **Friday 10 July 2025**. The voluntary contribution for the workshop is **£12.50** per child. In the unlikely event that the costs cannot be covered by contributions, the workshop will be cancelled. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium the school can support you. The *Life Long Ago* fossil dig school workshop brings prehistoric life to your school. In the large sandboxes, the children locate and identify fossils from some of the most iconic dinosaurs of the past. Tyrannosaurus Rex, Stegosaurus, Triceratops and a few other surprises are all thrown in. The children will learn when each dinosaur lived, where they came from, what they ate and much more.
