Year 6 Science Workshop

Year 6 has planned an exciting workshop 'Circulation and Heart Dissection' as part of our science biology topic last term. Circulation and Heart Dissection is a carefully supervised and truly inspiring workshop. It really brings anatomy to life, and provides a unique learning experience for children.

In this circulation and heart dissection workshop we will investigate -

- The function of the heart and how to keep it healthy
- Circulation of blood through the heart and lungs
- The anatomy of the heart and the roles of the different parts
- How to dissect a lamb's heart safely and identify the main structures
- Diseases of the heart and how surgeons can repair defects such as holes in the heart.

This workshop is run in a very clinical manner. It shows respect for cultural sensitivities. It is, of course, fully risk assessed.

All classes will be taking part in the workshop on **Thursday 11th December 2025**. The cost of this workshop is **£6** which will cover the visiting scientist and all the materials that the children will be using in the workshop.
