To say how you get somewhere, we use the phrase "**Voy en...**" (I go by...). Gender Agreement:

Un = Masculine (usually ends in -o)

Una = Feminine (usually ends in -a)

## Culture

**Spain has some very special ways of moving around that look a bit different from home!**

The Super-Fast Train (AVE): Spain has a train called the AVE. In Spanish, ave also means "bird." It is one of the fastest trains in the world, traveling at over 300 km/h! It connects big cities like Madrid and Barcelona in a flash.

r

In tren or barco, try to flick your tongue against the roof of your mouth.

e

Sounds like the 'e' in 'elephant'.




