Year 1 Trip to London Transport Museum

Year 1 have planned an exciting visit to London Transport Museum as part of the topic 'Wheely Great Transport'. The purpose of the visit will be to explore the changes to transport over the years.

Grasshopper and Butterfly Class will be visiting the Museum on **Tuesday 10th June 2025**.

Ladybird and Dragonfly Class will be visiting the Museum on **Tuesday 17th June 2025**.

We will be travelling by tube. We would like you to drop your child off and pick them up at Oakwood station on the day of your child's trip to the London Transport Museum. The class will travel directly to the museum from Oakwood Station to Covent Garden.

Your child's class teacher will meet you at Oakwood station at 9.10am for registration and a prompt departure. We will return to Oakwood station at 2.45pm where you will need to collect your child from. Please advise your class teacher if there will be someone different than usual picking up your child. Children who normally attend breakfast club will be brought to the station, via the school minibus, to meet their class teacher and taken back to school if they attend afterschool club.

The cost of this trip is **£5** which will cover a workshop investigating how travel was different in the past. No additional spending money is permitted. In the unlikely event that the costs cannot be covered by contributions, the trip will be cancelled. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium the school can support you. Payments to be paid via Arbor > Trips > Transport Museum by Friday 6th June 2025 at the latest.

Your child is entitled to Universal Free School Meals so The Pantry can provide a packed lunch which will need to be ordered on The Pantry website. Please follow these instructions:

1. *Log into your Pantry account.*
2. *On the dashboard click on view, under the name of the trip and the required meal.*
3. *Under upcoming events, click on details to select the required meal.*
4. *Once you have selected the required meal click on the green book button.*
5. *You then need to click on the tick box to give consent, then click the green confirm order button.*
6. *The packed lunch is now booked; you can view, amend or cancel the order by clicking on the details button.*
7. *Please remember to cancel your main hot meal if you have booked one.*
8. *Please ensure that your child brings a bottle of water with them for the trip.*
9. *ALL lunches to be ordered via The Pantry by 4pm on Wednesday 4th June 2025 as the ordering system will be closed after this date*

Please do not order a school packed lunch if you are going to send your own packed lunch.
