<p>Communication and Partnership</p>	<p>Maintaining a polite and courteous and professional environment at all times.</p> <p>Informing parents regularly about their child's academic progress, behaviour and attendance.</p> <p>Communicating with parents to share positive news on progress, behaviour, attendance or punctuality.</p> <p>Communicating with parents if there are concerns regarding progress, behaviour, attendance or punctuality.</p> <p>Ensuring communication between the school and parents is effective.</p>	<p>Talking to a trusted adult in school if I'm unhappy and to keep trying until I am heard.</p> <p>Sharing my school day honestly with my parents and participating in restorative conversations to solve problems.</p> <p>Talking at home about what I learn at school to share my progress with my family.</p> <p>Participating in school life as an ambassador for Grange Park.</p>	<p>Maintaining polite, professional, and personal communication with the school at all times.</p> <p>Using a personal conversation or meeting as the required first step to resolve issues.</p> <p>Following the school's formal escalation pathway (starting with the Class Teacher); ensuring any escalated correspondence includes details of previous informal discussions and allowing reasonable time for matters to be looked into.</p> <p>Acknowledging that there may be multiple perspectives to a situation and remaining reasonable and proportionate when raising concerns.</p> <p>Focusing concerns solely on my own child, refraining from using collective platforms to raise concerns, and accepting that, to protect privacy, the school cannot discuss other children with me.</p> <p>Using parent WhatsApp groups only for sharing school information rather than discussing children, staff, or policy.</p> <p>Considering the ethical implications of using AI and ensuring correspondence remains authentic and personal.</p>
