



Vaccines - what do they do?

Vaccination UK offers these vaccines for children in school or at our community catch up clinics.

DTP

**Protects against Diphtheria, Tetanus & Polio.
This is a Booster, the 5th dose in Redbook.**

Offered to 4 to 19 years old

Flu

**Protects against the 4 main groups
of flu type A and Type B viruses.**

Offered to Reception to Year 11 (23 years old if in SEN school)

HPV

**Protects against Human Papilloma Virus
that can lead to certain types of Cancer**

Offered to boys and girls 12 to 19 years old

MenACWY

**Protects against 4 different causes
of Meningitis and Septicaemia.**

Offered to 13 to 19 years old

MMR

**Protects against
Measles, Mumps & Rubella.**

If your child has missed the vaccine as a baby, we can offer the vaccination in school, aged 4 - 19 years old.
