### **Learning Conversations Spring 2026: Reception to Year 6**

We are excited to invite you into school for Learning Conversations on **Thursday 12 February 2026, from 2:00–7:30pm**, for Reception to Year 6.

**Important: Early School Closure at 1:45 pm** Please note that on this day, school will finish at **1:45 pm** for all children. Please arrange to collect your child promptly at this time. Children who normally walk home alone will be allowed to leave at this earlier time.

**After-School Clubs** As previously stated, there will be **no enrichment clubs** on this day. However, as is usual when school closes at 1:45 pm, Extend Afterschool Club will be open from this earlier time. You can book your place via Arbor. The price structure for this extended session (which includes the regular snacks) is:

- **1:45 pm – 4:30 pm:** £12.50
- **4:30 pm – 6:00 pm:** An additional £4.50

Appointments will be available to book via Arbor from **6:00pm on Friday 23 January until 9:00am on Monday 9 February**. On the Arbor homepage, you will receive a notification that a Guardian consultation has been set up and appointments are available to book. Please select the booking page and make your appointment.

Parents will be asked to choose a **ten-minute session** at a time most convenient for them. Appointments will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. If you have more than one child, please ensure you leave sufficient time between appointments to avoid any overlaps.

During the conversation, your child's teacher will discuss how your child has engaged in their learning, their current targets, and how they are building relationships within the class since the last Learning Conversation. Out of courtesy to other parents, please ensure appointments keep to time.

Members of the headship team will be available to speak with parents; however, please arrange these appointments separately via the school office. On arrival, you will also have the opportunity to look at your child's books to help inform and support your discussion with the class teacher.

Your child is invited to join you for the learning conversations. We look forward to sharing your child's progress with you at this important event.
