Learning Conversations Spring 2026- Nursery

We are excited to invite you into school for Learning Conversations on **Thursday 12 February 2026, from 11:30–7:30pm**, for Nursery.

On this day, the school will be closing at 1.45pm. This will therefore affect the timings of your child's sessions. Please collect your child promptly:

- If your child usually attends the morning session, the timings are amended to: 8.30am - 10.45am
- If your child usually attends the afternoon session, the timings are amended to: 11.45am - 1.45pm.

After-School Clubs As is usual when school closes at 1:45 pm, Extend Afterschool Club will be open from this earlier time. You can book your place via Arbor. The price structure for this extended session (which includes the regular snacks) is:

- **1:45 pm – 4:30 pm:** £12.50
- **4:30 pm – 6:00 pm:** An additional £4.50

Appointments will be available to book via Arbor from **6:00pm on Friday 23 January until 9:00am on Monday 9 February**. On the Arbor homepage, you will receive a notification that a Guardian consultation has been set up and appointments are available to book. Please select the booking page and make your appointment.

Parents will be asked to choose a **ten-minute session** at a time most convenient for them. Appointments will be allocated on a first-come, first-served basis. If you have more than one child, please ensure you leave sufficient time between appointments to avoid any overlaps.

On arrival, please enter through the front of the school.

- Meetings between 11:40 - 2:00: Meeting room (off the office)
- Meetings between 2:00 - 7:30: Acorns Classroom

During the conversation, your child's teacher will discuss how your child has engaged in their learning, their current targets, and how they are building relationships within the class since the last Learning Conversation. Out of courtesy to other parents, please ensure appointments keep to time.

Members of the headship team will be available to speak with parents; however, please arrange these appointments separately via the school office. Your child is invited to join you for the learning conversations. We look forward to sharing your child's progress with you at this important event.
