Woodcroft Wildspace

Year 3 have planned an exciting visit to Woodcroft Wildspace as part of our Science topic about plants. The purpose of the visit will be to look at, sort and classify different types of plants and to further our knowledge of the function of each part of a plant. We will also be looking closely at how the change of seasons affects the natural world.

Willow will be visiting Woodcroft on Tuesday 23 September 2025.

Oak will be visiting Woodcroft on Friday 26 September 2025

Ash will be visiting Woodcroft on Tuesday 30 September 2025.

Cedar will be visiting Woodcroft on Friday 3 October 2025.

On the day of the trip, please drop your child off at **Woodcroft Wildspace** (Downes Court, N21 3PT) between **9:15 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.** We've found that walking both ways can be quite tiring for the children, so this arrangement will ensure they only need to walk back to school. You may consider coordinating drop-offs with other parents to help with drop offs. If your child attends **Breakfast Club**, we will provide transportation via the school minibus. We will return to school in time for a normal school lunch.

The cost of this trip is £3 which will cover the workshop at the venue. No additional spending money is permitted. In the unlikely event that the costs cannot be covered by contributions, the trip will be cancelled. If your child is eligible for Pupil Premium the school can support you. Payments to be paid via Arbor > Trips > Woodcroft Wildspace by Friday 3 October 2025 at the latest.

Your child should wear a school uniform and ensure they have a warm coat, suitable for possible rainy conditions. At times, Woodcroft can become **quite muddy** so it is advisable that your child has **suitable footwear** in the event that this is the case.

All children on our asthma register must make sure they have an up to date pump with them on the day. Children without their pumps will not be allowed to go.
