### **Southgate Progressive Synagogue**

Year 4 have planned an exciting visit to Southgate Progressive Synagogue as part of our topic about Jewish festivals. The purpose of the visit will be to learn about Judaism and Jewish places of worship. This is an educational trip, providing the children with the opportunity to see different places of worship, at no point will children be actively involved in any prayers or acts of worship.

We will be walking. The Children will be leaving school promptly at 9:15 and will return at 12:30 in time for a normal lunch at school.
