

## Home Learning Guidance: Nursery

- Our Nursery home learning supports all areas of the EYFS Framework, additional activities to those set below may also be suggested throughout the year.
- Nursery begin this program of home learning in Autumn 2 (after the children have had some time to settle into the routines nursery have in place)
- All home learning is set on a Friday and due back the following Friday morning (at the latest).
- Home learning is set out on a weekly timetable that includes useful links in order for children and adults to access it easily. These timetables also include additional subscriptions and optional home learning.
- When home learning is submitted on Tapestry there will be an acknowledgement by the teacher.

| <b>Nursery</b> | <p>Each week, the children will bring home a reading for pleasure book.</p> <p>A nursery rhyme is shared on Tapestry to help children develop a love of rhyming language. We encourage families to read or sing these rhymes together at home.</p> <p>As children progress, additional fun phonics games and activities will be shared throughout the year.</p> | <p>The focus story is shared with parents and links to our in-class learning. This helps children become familiar with the language, characters, and themes. You can talk about the story, act it out, or retell it together at home. A suggested activity will also be provided to support this learning.</p> <p>A mark-making activity linked to the current story or classroom focus will be suggested to encourage early writing development and support fine motor skills.</p> | <p>A practical maths activity linked to classroom learning will be shared each week. These hands-on tasks help children develop their counting, sorting, and problem-solving skills through play.</p> |
