Outcomes uploaded to Tapestry by parents.</p> <p>Word of the week sent home to be used and practised.</p> <p>Soundbook throughout the year to consolidate sounds. For those able to do so, whole word and sentence practice.</p>	<p>Maths activities (starting in Autumn 2) posted on Tapestry.
